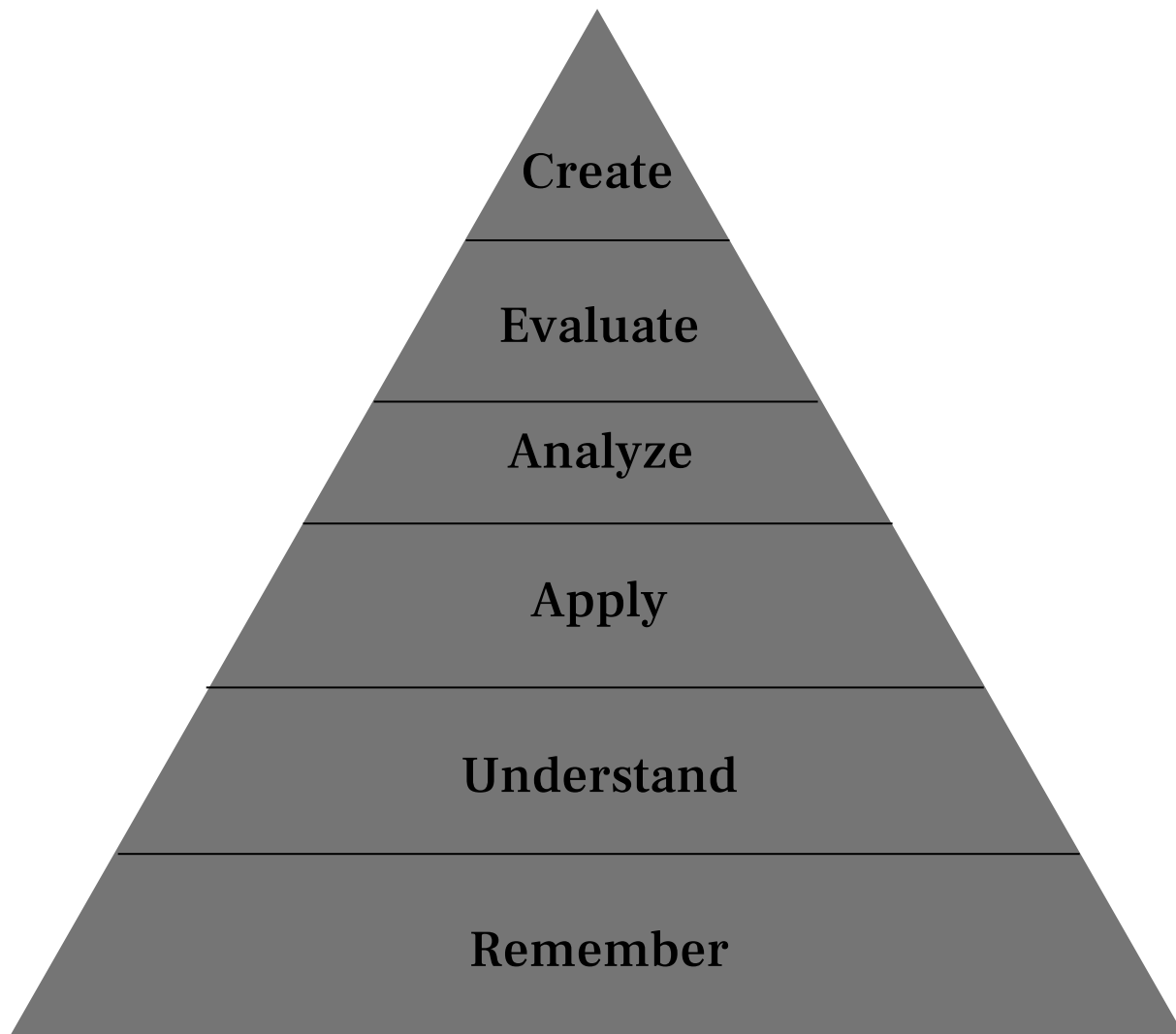


# Bloom's Taxonomy

Bloom's Taxonomy is often represented as a pyramid of the different types of learning. At the high school level, students are asked to remember and understand. At the collegiate level, students learn to apply, analyze, evaluate, and create.
